Media Archaeology and Intermedial Performance Nele Wynants 2018-12-30

This book develops media archaeological approaches to theatre and intermediality. As an age-old art form, theatre has always embraced 'new' media. To create theatrical effects and optical illusions, theatre makers were ready to integrate state-of-the-art technics and technologies, and by doing so

they playfully explored and popularized scientific knowledge on mechanics, optics and sound for live audiences. This book highlights this obvious but often overlooked relation between media developments and the history of intermedial theater. By considering the interplay between present intermedial performances and their archaeological traces, the authors assembled here revisit old and often forgotten media approaches and theatre technologies. This archaeology is understood less as the discovery of a forgotten past than as the establishment of an active relationship between past and present. Rather than treating archaeological remains as representative tokens of a fragmented past that need to be preserved, the authors stress the return of the past

in the present, but in a different, performative guise.

Siegfried Kracauer's American

Writings Siegfried Kracauer

2012-06-01 Siegfried Kracauer (1889–1966), friend and colleague of Walter Benjamin and Theodor Adorno,

was one of the most influential film critics of the mid-twentieth century. In this book, Johannes von Moltke and Kristy Rawson have, for the first time assembled essays in cultural criticism, film, literature, and media theory that Kracauer wrote during the quarter century he spent in America after fleeing Nazi-occupied Europe. In the decades following his arrival in the United States, Kracauer commented on developments in American and European cinema, wrote on film noir and neorealism, examined unsettling political trends in mainstream cinema, and reviewed the contemporary experiments of avant-garde filmmakers. As a cultural critic, he also ranged far beyond cinema, intervening in debates regarding Jewish culture, unraveling national

and racial stereotypes, and reflecting on the state of arts and humanities in the 1950s. These essays, together with the editors' introductions and an afterward by Martin Jay offer illuminating insights into the films and culture of the postwar years and provide a unique perspective on this eminent émigré intellectual.

Memoirs of an Egotist Stendhal

It was between these dates that he moved to Paris and here looks back on his life as an eccentric bachelor. 'As well as Beyle the clairvoyant self-investigator, the sardonic analyst of Parisian salon society and deliberate cultivator of wit, here emerges Beyle the despairing lover, the shakespearean enthusiast, whose romantic sentiment run always parallel with his eighteenth-century logic'. Marie-Henri Beyle - better-known by his pen name, Stendhal - was

born in Grenoble, France in 1783. He turned to writing after the final defeat of Napoleon in 1815, notable works include *A Life of Rossini* (1824), *A Life of Napoleon* (1929) and *The Red and the Black* published in 1830. A number of works were published posthumously, including *Lamuel* (1889), *Memoirs of an Egotist* (1892) and *Lucien Leuwen* (1894). Stendhal is now regarded as one of the earliest and foremost practitioners of literary realism.

Essays on Fascism Benito Mussolini
2019-03-25 "The Ideology of Fascism" was written by Oswald Mosley in 1967 and provides a post WW2 analysis of the strengths and weaknesses of Fascism as a political doctrine, and utilising its strengths proposes a United Europe, in union with science, as a prime requirement for the 21st Century. "The Doctrine of Fascism" was written by Benito Mussolini and the Italian philosopher Giovanni Gentile. A key concept of which was that fascism was a rejection of previous models: "If the 19th century was the century of the individual we are free to believe that this is the 'collective' century, and therefore the century of the State." Giovanni Gentile was inspired by Italian intellectuals such as Mazzini,

Rosmini, Gioberti, and Spaventa from whom he developed the idea of "self-construction," but also was strongly influenced by the German idealist and materialist schools of thought - namely Marx, Hegel, Fichte, and Nietzsche. Gentile was described by Mussolini, as 'the philosopher of Fascism'. Alfredo Rocco developed the economic and political theory of corporatism which would become part of the Fascist Manifesto of the National Fascist Party. Rocco denounced the European powers for imposing foreign culture on Italy and criticized the European powers for endorsing too much liberalism and individualism. The Fascist Manifesto was endorsed by a large number of intellectuals, and writers, including Luigi Pirandello, Gabriele D'Annunzio, Filippo Tommaso Marinetti

and Giuseppe Ungaretti.
Édith Piaf David Looseley 2015-10-28
An Open Access edition of this book is available on the Liverpool University Press website and through Knowledge Unlatched. The world-famous French singer Édith Piaf (1915-63) was never just a singer. Dozens of biographies of her, of variable quality, have seldom got beyond the well known and usually contested 'facts' of her life. This book suggests new ways of understanding her. A 'cultural history' of Piaf means exploring her cultural, social and political significance as a national and international icon, looking at her shifting meanings over time, at home and abroad. How did she become a star and a myth? What did she come to mean in life and in death? At the centenary of her birth

and more than fifty years after her passing, why do we still remember her work and commemorate her through the work of others, from Claude Nougaro and Elton John to Ben Harper and Zaz, as well as in films, musicals, documentaries and tribute acts around the world? What does she mean today? The book proposes the notion of an imagined Piaf. To a large extent, she was her own invention, not only by virtue of her talent but because she produced narratives about herself, building a mystery. But she was also the invention of others: of those she worked with but above all of her audiences, who made their own meanings from her carefully staged performances. Since her death, the world has been free to imagine new Piafs. From the 1930s until today, she has variously embodied

conceptions of the 'popular' and of 'chanson' as a new kind of middlebrow, of gender, sexuality, national identity and the human condition.

Du cerveau à Dieu Mario Beauregard
2015-12-09 Pour tenter de répondre à cette épineuse question, le neuroscientifique Mario Beauregard a demandé à quinze Soeurs carmélite de prêter leur concours à une expérience scientifique. En examinant l'activité cérébrale de ces religieuses au cours de leur expérience mystique, il a découvert que les pratiques spirituelles ne sont pas reliées à une zone spécifique du cerveau, mais à plusieurs "régions et systèmes cérébraux" habituellement destinés à des fonctions telles que la perception, les émotions ou la conscience de soi. Loin s'en faut : les expériences mystiques révèlent la capacité des individus à entrer en contact avec une force objectivement réelle, transcendantale, un au-delà d'eux-mêmes, du temps et de l'espace. D'où les nombreux phénomènes psychiques qui demeurent inexplicés par la science, tels que les guérisons "miraculeuses ", l'effet placebo, les prémonitions, les

expériences de mort imminente (EMI ou NDE), le sentiment d'union lors de la prière ou la méditation ...

Salutaire, édifiant, ce livre s'écarte de la tendance générale des travaux de neurosciences en remettant en question l'idéologie matérialiste dominante. Il nous montre que si la science est incapable de prouver ou d'infirmer l'existence de l'âme, elle ne saurait pour autant persister à la nier.

OEuvres Henri Bergson 2015-11-25
Bergson a connu une carrière à la fois brillante et traditionnelle : ancien élève de l'École normale supérieure, agrégé de philosophie, il devient professeur de lycée et soutient sa thèse, Essai sur les données immédiates de la conscience, en 1889. Maître de conférence à l'École normale supérieure en 1898,

il est élu deux plus tard au Collège de France où ses cours vont attirer un auditoire considérable. En 1907, après la parution de L'Évolution Créatrice, sa réputation devient une gloire mondiale ; on parle de bergsonisme comme on a pu parler de cartésianisme ou de kantisme, plusieurs ouvrages d'importance lui sont consacrés, et la hauteur de sa pensée comme le brio de son écriture lui valent d'être élu à l'Académie française en 1914 et de recevoir en 1928 le prix Nobel de littérature. À partir de la découverte de la durée, un nouveau spiritualisme philosophique se met en place dans son œuvre, appuyé sur l'étude critique des sciences, mais aussi lié à une conscience animée d'un élan vital, et l'intuition va devenir un thème majeur de la doctrine de

Bergson qui s'attache à fonder un pragmatisme moderne et une doctrine d'élévation de l'âme. Et cependant sa philosophie suscite des hostilités : son spiritualisme lui vaut d'être taxé d'irrationalisme, sa philosophie de la vie est critiquée par les catholiques, et sa conception du temps par Einstein. Après sa mort, il arrive qu'on voit en Bergson un philosophe académique dont il convient de se détourner, et sa pensée, pour une part passée dans le domaine commun, perd sa force incisive : c'est précisément elle qu'il convient de retrouver pour une lecture renouvelée de son œuvre.
