SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS IN THE U.S. ARMED FORCES INSTITUTE OF MEDICINE 2013-03-21 PROBLEMS STEMMING FROM THE MISUSE AND ABUSE OF ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUGS ARE BY NO MEANS A NEW PHENOMENON, ALTHOUGH THE FACE OF THE ISSUES HAS CHANGED IN RECENT YEARS. NATIONAL TRENDS INDICATE SUBSTANTIAL INCREASES IN THE ABUSE OF PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS. THESE INCREASES ARE PARTICULARLY PROMINENT WITHIN THE MILITARY, A POPULATION THAT ALSO CONTINUES TO EXPERIENCE LONG-STANDING ISSUES WITH ALCOHOL ABUSE.
