## The Crisis Text Line set to Launch in August

24/7 hotlines exist for teens in need of toll-free numbers and chat, but there is still a need for crisis support over the SMS. We have been working to launch, separate from DoSomething.org, a text line for young people in crisis

DoSomething isn't a hotline, but its CEO, Nancy Lublin, decided to, well, do something. Debbie Gant-Reed sees the need every day. She's the crisis lines coordinator at a 24-hour help line in Reno, Nev., called the [Crisis Call Center](#). The center has been providing 24-hour text help for two and a half years, fielding about 500 text conversations a month.

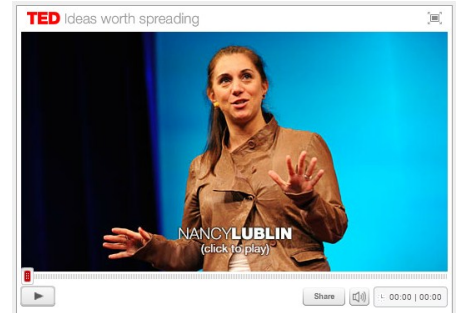
